

The Countdown to GDPR Compliance



Before Lift Off begins, consider these keys questions;

- > WHO is handling/has access to your data?
- > WHERE is the personal data being kept?
- > WHAT is the personal data being used for?
- > HOW is the data being protected?



Consider the rights of the data subject when processing personal data

- > To be informed
- > Of access to data
- > To correct/rectify data
- > To be forgotten
- > To restrict processing
- > Data portability
- > To object
- > Implications of automation



Are you a data controller or processor?

Controller

A legal person who (either alone or jointly) says how and why personal data is processed.

Processor

Any person (other than an employee of the controller) who acts on the controller's behalf.

Either way, you need to be GDPR compliant



In the event of non-compliance, you could face a penalty of up to €20M

You will have **72 hours** to notify authorities in the event of a data breach.



You may be required to have a Data Protection Officer



Time to Destination



This is the date the GDPR becomes official and penalties apply. This still applies to the UK, regardless of EU membership.
